

Adventurer Songs

The Youth Resources Committee (Southern Region) met in May 2007 and discussed the Adventurer Song.

It was found that there are at least two songs already widely used in this Division; New Zealand Adventurers sing the song by Robyn Dunlop, while in the islands another song is generally used. In view of the fact that Adventurers rarely meet outside of their own Conference area, it was decided that these two songs should continue to be used in the areas that have already adopted them, and that elsewhere the Local Youth Department can select a song for their area.

This file lists on the following pages some Adventurer Songs for your consideration.

The one on the next page comes from Robyn Dunlop formerly of Wellington, New Zealand, but now in South Queensland and is used in New Zealand.

The next was written some years ago for the Illawara Club (Greater Sydney) by Christine Carr. This is a better copy than the one used before.

The third is the song used in the Islands. We give the words first then the words and music.

The fourth is one written when we were looking for a new Division wide song for the Division, and comes from Tammy Cinzio of North New South Wales.

The fifth is a special song for to help Adventurers learn the Pledge and Law, and comes from Cynthia Delaney of Queensland.

The North American Division Adventurer Manual (in the version I have) contains three different Adventurer songs, plus a song for the Pledge and one for the Law. However that Division has now chosen an official song and it can be found in four formats on their Adventurer Web site at <http://www.adventurer-club.org/Music/Music.htm>.

There are two versions here with children singing, and two with the music only (backing tracks). A CD with these versions of their song can also be purchased.
