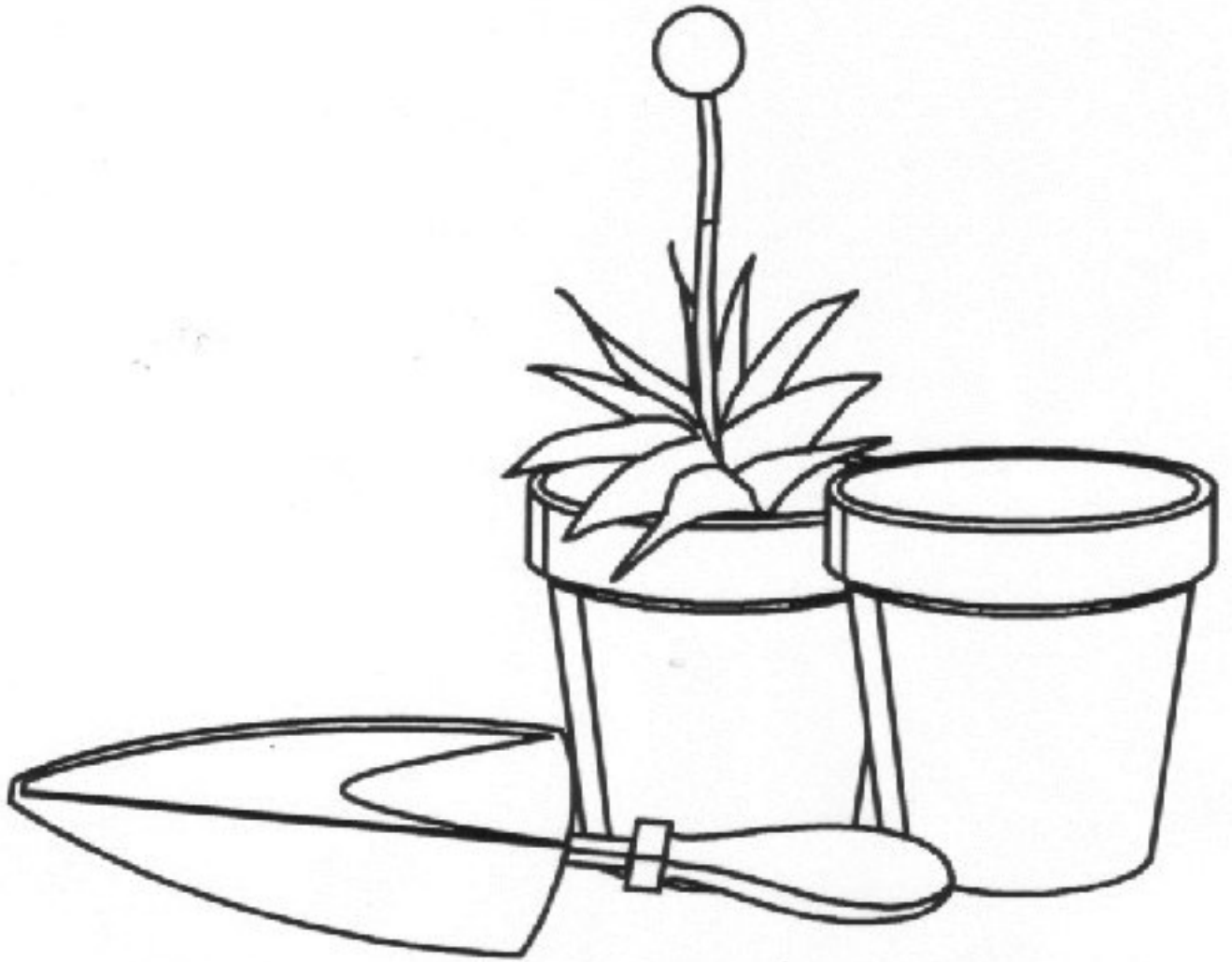
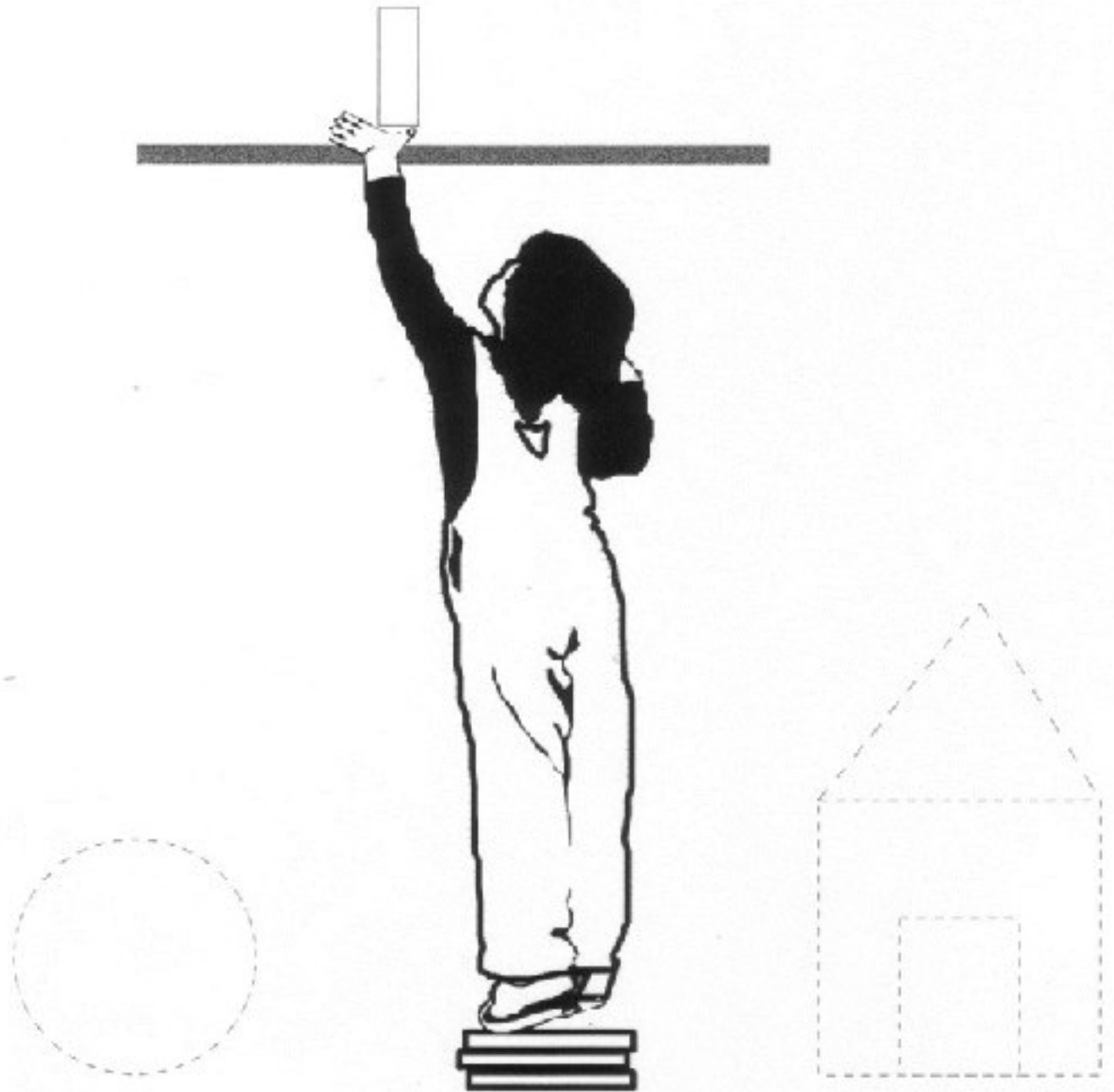


# In The Garden



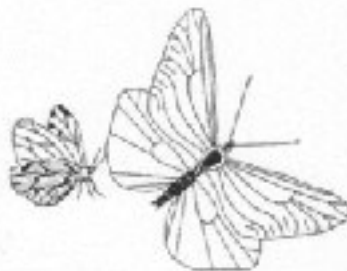
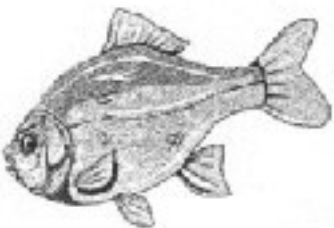
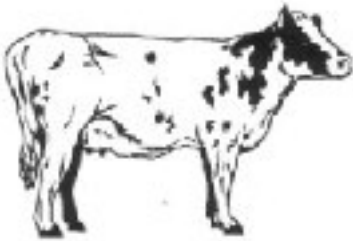
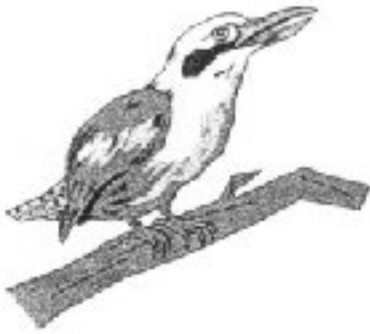
Teachers, have the children paste the flower, leaf, spade and the flower pot from the coloured pages (appendix sheets) onto the correct space. Set up a small garden that the children can plant and tend to. This may be a small window box, a few pot plants or a small garden plot. Vegetable or flower seeds are the most rewarding. Explain that plants need water, food from the soil, and light, in order to grow.

# I Like To Help



Teachers, talk to the children about helping around the home. Have them trace around the ball and the doll's house. Tell them about how adults appreciate them helping when they are asked. Ask them what they have done to help an adult around the home when they were asked.

# Show Me . . .



Teachers, this game can be played two ways - have the children point to the different animals "Show me the koala . . ." or have the children look at the page for a few minutes and then close the book and have them try and remember three animals. This can be increased according to the number of times played, the interest and the ability of the children.
